1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The company has incorporated as a limited company under Thai civil and commercial laws on 1 September 2014, registered number 0105557127631. The company provides consulting services, offering advice and solutions for problems related to chemical products used in plating or coating.

Head office is located at 567/42 Pradya biz home at Onnuch, Onnuch road, Prawet Sub-district, Prawet District, Bangkok.

2. BASIS FOR PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statement has been prepared in accordance with Thai Financial Reporting Standard applicable to Non-Publicly Accountable Entities ("NPAEs") (revised 2022) as issued by the Federation of Accounting Profession and their presentation has been made in compliance with the stipulation of the Notification of the Department of Business Development regarding the determination of the abbreviated items required in the financial statements year 2024 dated 27 October 2023 issued in accordance with the Accounting Act of 2000.

The financial statements in Thai language are the official statutory financial statements of the Company.

The financial statements in English language have been translated from the Thai language financial statements.

The financial statements have been prepared on a historical cost basis except where otherwise disclosed in the accounting policies.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

3.1 Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents consist of cash, cash at financial institution and short-term highly liquid investment with an original maturity of three months or less from the date of acquisition excluding deposit at financial institutions used as collateral.

3.2 Trade accounts receivable

Trade accounts receivable are stated at face value, net of allowance for doubtful accounts.

The allowance for doubtful accounts is provided based on the estimated collection losses that may be incurred in the collection process. The estimated losses are based on historical collection experiences together with a review of the current status of receivables.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

3.3 Inventories

Inventories are stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value, cost being determined by first infirst out basis.

3.4 Equipment and depreciations

Equipment is stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciations is calculated by using straight-line method based on the estimated useful lives 5 years at the rate 20%.

3.5 Revenue and expense recognition

Revenues and expenses were recorded on an accrual basis.

3.6 Foreign currency transactions

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies incurred during the year are translated into Baht at the exchange rate on the transactions' dates. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies at the statement of financial position date are translated into Baht at the reference exchange rates established by the Bank of Thailand on that date.

Gain or loss on foreign exchange arising on settlement and transaction are recognized as income or expense in the statement of income.

3.7 Use of management's judgments

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles also requires the Company's management to exercise judgements in order to determine the accounting policies, estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenue and expense during the reporting period. Although these estimates are based on management's reasonable consideration of current events, actual results may differ from this estimation.
